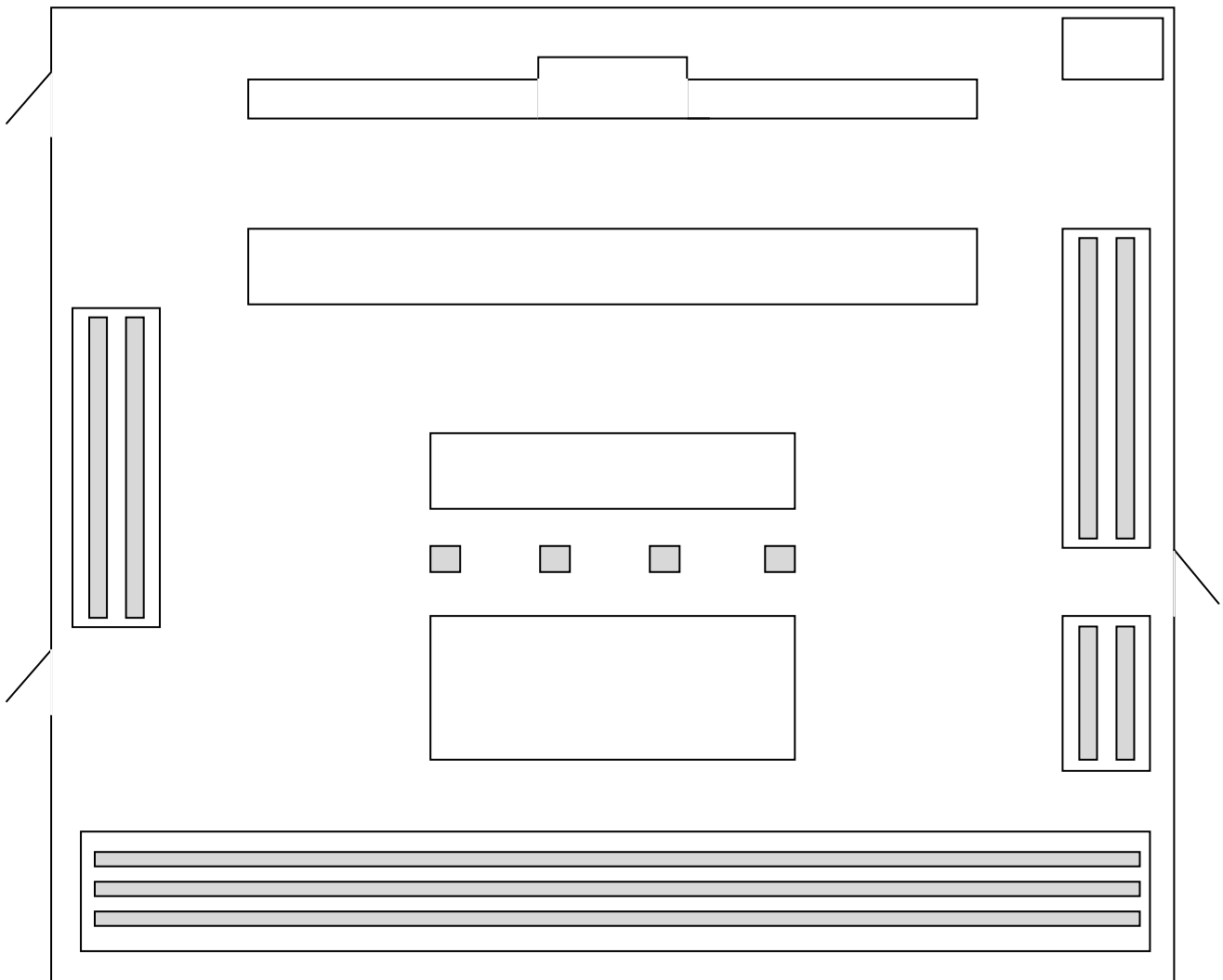
CONDUCT AT COURT – It is important when attending court that students:
